What is a Variance?

- A variance is a request that seeks permission to attend a school other than the one to which a student should be enrolled under the LPS assignment policy.
 - The LPS school assignment policy is centered on neighborhood schools, generally assigning students to the schools closest to their homes.
 - While our district schools deliver instructional services to meet the diverse needs of students in their neighborhoods, there are instances when students may benefit from attending a school other than their neighborhood one. The policy provides an orderly and thoughtful process for variances to the assignment policy.

Requested Change to Rule Five of the "Rules for Enrollment on a Variance"

- 5. The granting of a variance is privilege. As such, it can be revoked and students re-assigned to their neighborhood school at the end of any given marking period if:
 - A student's attendance in classes falls below 97% due to absence, tardiness, or dismissal
 - A student is suspended for any disciplinary action

Requested Change to Rule Five of the "Rules for Enrollment on a Variance"

- 5. The granting of a variance is privilege. As such, it can be revoked and students re-assigned to their neighborhood school at the end of any given marking period if:
 - A student's attendance in school falls below Massachusetts'
 definition of Chronic Absenteeism of at least 10% of days
 enrolled (e.g., 18 days absent if enrolled for 180) classes falls
 below 97% due to absence, tardiness, or dismissal*
 - A student receives out of school suspension for a total of five or more cumulative days. is suspended for any disciplinary action.

Variance Timeline

Seeking approval of the amendment so that changes are reflected in the upcoming variance application round:

- Currently enrolled families are invited to apply for a school assignment variance between May 1 and the last day of school, June 22
 - Letters have been mailed home
 - Decisions are communicated by July 1.
- New to LPS families and those who relocate to a new school catchment area may apply for a school variance on a rolling basis.
