- ❖ Given continued HIGH RATES of Community Spread in Lawrence, the return of <u>selected</u> HIGH NEEDS students is occurring as a <u>very</u> limited and controlled phased-in approach
- ❖ ENHANCED PPE and PROTOCOLS are in place including Daily Temperature Checks and the Abbott Binax Now Rapid Antigen Test Binax for symptomatic students and staff

- In total, 414 STAFF MEMBERS indicated interest in returning In Person.
- Principals prioritized High Needs learners matched to In Person staff members to include the following groups:
 - Special Education Students assigned to District Programs
 - Newcomer English Learners
 - Homeless Students or those living in Foster Care
 - Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Students
 - Other HIGH NEEDS students experiencing connectivity or remote learning challenges
 - The schedule for In-Person learning is MONDAY FRIDAY (same hours as remote)
