# Data Analysis Continued

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Covid and Variant sparked concern about in person learning for some parents.

- Roughly half of parents returned students to in-person learning last spring

Parents who could choose to keep their children home, did:

- PK
- Kindergarten
- Home School
- Summer withdrawals

Enrollment numbers will continue to change

- January is typically a second, smaller peak
- Work will need to be done to market LPS schools to families for next year
