

6A.1 Summary

A. Basic Project Information

The asisting Oliver Partmenthis School is located at 183 Heverhill Street, Lawrence, MA. It is bordered by Oak Street and O'Nell Park to the north and Haverhill Street and the historic Campagenore Common to the south. Its neighbort to the west is an Evangelical Church, school parking and a vacant City-owned lot that the achool also uses for parking. To the east is the historic Robert Frost house, Cardillo Way (a public passage), and several vacant parcels owned by the Lawrence Redevelopment Authority (LRA). The existing school parel is 1.23 acres and the existing building is 75,116 gsf and serves approximately 500 students in grades 1-5. 
The existing Henry K Oliver school is on the historic register and local zooling requirements limit building height to 40 feet. In order to keep the building height as low as possible, retain the most critical portions of the existing historic building, and serve the program. A Project Notification form was submitted to Massachusetts Historic Commission (MHC) on November 25, 2019 that included both the Stone Mill Add/Rena and the Oliver Partnership Add/Rena and a response was received on December 23, 2019. The



response requested updated project information after further development. The project team has submitted an updated Project Notification Form on November 11, 2020 and received an exposence on December 11, 2020. Subsequently, SIMMA has met with the Lawrence Historical Commission (LHC) and plans to present to the Prospect Historical Commission within the next morth. A valvey of Lawrence's Body requirement Deby requirement beginning granted on June 14, 2021, by the LHC. The follow-up response to NHC was sent on June 24, 2021, and included a letter of support for the project from the LHC dated June 16, 2021.


