### **Need for EXPANDING INTEGRATED PREK**

- •Integrated PreK offers a curriculum with focus on social and emotional development through play-based learning and alignment with MA PRE-K common core standards in a HALF-DAY program (2.75 Hours/Day).
- •Our inclusive preschool program welcomes students with and without disabilities.
- •Due to limited space as well as specially designed programs, placement in a neighborhood school is not always possible.
- •For students eligible for special education services due to a disability, the range of service will vary in the integrated classrooms.
- •The exact type of instruction/therapy and frequency of service is determined by the Team at an initial eligibility meeting and agreed upon in a signed IEP.

#### **EARLY INTERVENTION HAD A MAKEOVER!**

•This team includes evaluators – School Psychologist,
Occupational Therapist, Speech and Language Pathologist, and Physical Therapist



- •The Team conducts "arena" style evaluations for students referred with suspicion of a disability beginning at age 2.9
- Most children are referred from early intervention services
- Some children are referred by their parents, doctors, caregivers, and daycare providers based on concerns
- During SY 20-21 approx. 150 EIST evaluations were conducted virtually via ZOOM due to the COVID-19 pandemic

#### LPS INTEGRATED PREK

**CURRENTLY 20 FTEs = 40 (2.75 HOUR) SESSIONS** 

280 IEP SEATS + 320 TYPICAL SEATS = 600 SEATS

- Request waiver for class size
- ADDITIONAL SESSIONS needed for 2022-23

#### REMINDERS...

- We are required to offer integrated PREK to all students who qualify for an IEP beginning at age 3.
- Waivers are available when we are unable to balance the ratios (identified:typical) or when there is a need to increase class size.
- Our district leaders have been willing to open new classes this year (LFA, ARL, BRE) to keep us in compliance – LFA is willing to open another! THANK YOU!
- This year is an anomaly due to the pandemic

   parents did not have their children
   evaluated in the same numbers last year and did not enroll them while PREK was remote
   so we are seeing them this year.
- We appreciate the support and understanding of our PREK educators.
- Our Early Intervention Screening Team will likely evaluate up to 400 children by June – many thanks!
