Scale of Programming

Over 3000 students served:

- **ESY:** 345 students, 5 facilitators, 33 teachers, 105 paras, 24 related service providers
- Newcomer: 165 students, 1 facilitator, 16 teachers, counselor, 5 paras
- Level Up and HS: 2,500 students; 256 teachers;19 facilitators and 19 counselors
- **Music:** 60 students grades 3-11, 1 facilitator, 3 teachers, 1 para, 4 community partners

- Direct English language development, daily specials (P.E. and technology),
- Bilingual Library Access to bilingual books
- Curriculum: HANDs On English, Frames for Fluency with aligned Professional development for teachers
- Interventionist for Newcomers



Level Up (K-8) & High School Programming

- K-8: District purchased standards-aligned curriculum in Reading, Math, and Writing from iReady with aligned professional development
- HS: AP Summer Bridge Program, Rising Lancer Program to support the transition of incoming Freshmen, and credit recovery opportunities.
- All: Mix of academics, social emotional support, and enrichment activities
