#### LAE Board Meeting Update

February 14, 2024



Participating students receive at least 20 hours of additional instruction in a given subject over a week, which adds up to more hours of instruction in a core subject than a student gets in a typical <u>month</u> of school.

## **Key SY24 Acceleration Academy Goals**

- Refocus on the original rationale of Acceleration Academy to select students for high impact instruction by talented teachers
  - Renew focus on acceleration, not remediation as a vehicle to address unfinished learning
  - Build teacher capacity through district and DESE PD
  - Required licensure and lesson plans for teachers
- Provide professional learning to Math and Literacy instructional leaders on planning targeted, standards aligned programming aligned to the instructional vision and using data to select and group students
- Measure impact of acceleration academies on student growth as demonstrated on assessment (Dibels, MCAS, MAP)
  - Specify growth targets for all vacation-based programming

## **Program Logistics**

- Tuesday-Friday of February and April Vacation
  - February: ELA/Early Literacy
  - April: Math/Science
- Targeted small group instruction, social emotional supports, and enrichment provided
- Daily Motivational Incentives for Attendance
- Transportation provided for those who receive it during school year
